

### **Background of the Country**




- n Population 10 215 000

- Pediatricians (family pediatricians, GPPs, primary care pediatrician PCP)
- n General practitioners for adults (GPs)

Primary pediatric care:

n children 0 - 19 yearsn 98% registration




# GPP in out-patient care in 2005

- n 2 293 physicians GPP
- 9-11 physicians for children and adolescents per 10 000 inhabitants up to 19 years
- n 98 % private practices
- n The proportion of breast-fed children at the age of 6 months = 46%

### **Pediatric training**

- n Basic pediatric training 3 years
- n Special pediatric training 2 years
- 1. Primary care pediatrics
- 2. Secondary care pediatricians (hospital pediatrics)
- 3. Tertiary care pediatricians (pediatric sub specialists)
